

# TabletTools™ Keyboard User's Handbook

## Quick Start on the TabletTools Keyboard

### Installation and Version Information

#### Version

TabletTools Keyboard v1.3.1

Check for free updates and upgrade paths by clicking on the update icon (below):



TabletTools Suite (available as an upgrade) includes the complete set of usability tools any Tablet PC or UMPC running Windows XP with touch screen input.

#### Requirements

In order to install TabletTools, your computer must meet the following requirements:

1. Running Windows XP SP2 (Vista is not supported at this time)
2. 512MB RAM
3. 1.2GHz Processor (recommended minimum)
4. Microsoft .NET 1.0a installed
5. Microsoft .NET 2.0 installed
6. Touchscreen
7. TabletTools License (if you do not have a license, one can be obtained by going to <http://tablettools.cybernet.com/>).







To install, double click on the “TabletTools Installer” and follow the on-screen instructions and information. After installation is complete, restart your computer.

To uninstall, from the TabletTools menu off the Start menu, select the Uninstall icon and follow the onscreen instructions. Because of the nature of the keyboard being in use by the Windows login process, the uninstaller will not be able to remove the entirety of TabletTools from your computer, however, after rebooting, the keyboard will no longer be active and the remaining files (default location C:\Program Files\TabletTools) can be removed from your hard drive.


#### Activating the TabletTools Keyboard

The TabletTools virtual keyboard turns the touch screen into a nearly full-size QWERTY-type keyboard. Tap the {shift} key once to the keyboard for a single keypress

in capital letters mode. Tap the {shift} key twice (shift shows red) to lock the shift key. Tap {shift} again to unlock. The {pane} key on the keyboard displays a keyboard which includes a number pad. The keyboard is semi-transparent, so that the underlying applications are visible.

1. Tap the  icon on the tablet screen. This will open the virtual keyboard.
2. The keyboard is semi-transparent, so that the underlying applications are visible.
3.   and  keys—Tap any of these keys once to turn the key blue. A blue key is “pressed down.” More than one of these three keys can be blue at the same time. For example, tap Ctrl and then tap the Shift key for Ctrl-Shift.
4. The Shift key can be locked by pressing it twice. When locked, it appears blue with red lettering: . To unlock, press the Shift key one more time.
5. Tap the  on the module screen to close the virtual keyboard

To enter text, do the following:

1. Tap your finger in the box where you wish to enter text.
2. Tap the  icon on the tablet screen.
3. You’ll see the transparent keyboard overlay centered vertically on the screen.
4. Enter your text by pressing firmly on the desired keys.
5. Tapping the arrow keys will move the cursor.
6. Tapping the Bksp key on the keyboard will delete characters.
7. Pressing the Pane key will alternate between the Alphanumeric Keyboard Layout and Special Keys (e.g, function keys, number pad) layout.
8. Tap the Info key (from the Special Keys pane) to bring up extra information, version number, and a link to a TabletTools website that contains information on how to obtain free TabletTools Keyboard updates (when available) and how to purchase more advanced versions of TabletTools.
9. Press the EXIT button to turn off the keyboard.
